

## BE CONTINUOUS ON THE MIDDLE

Bismi Llāhi r-Raḥmāni r-Raḥīm:

Be in the middle state. Do not tire yourselves. And do not be lazy. Go on the same way continuously, your life will be smooth, and your ākhirah will be good. You will attain salvation and paradise. Otherwise, don't do things that you can't do. As we said, Allāh 'Azza wa-Jalla has power over everything. If He wills, He would not leave anyone without īmān. He would've made everyone Muslim.
