That's why, he will be subject to the wrath and anger of Allāh 'Azza wa-Jalla. He will be unsuccessful. He will gain nothing but evil. His end is poverty in dunyā and torment in ākhirah. Therefore, the elders must be careful. Sins that are easily committed are not profit. They are not benefit or gain. They are a torment to him. They are badness. May Allāh [®] protect us.

Do not give your ego any chance, in shā'a Llāh.
