Hadith Lesson: Friday the Master of Days

As-Salāmu 'Alaykum wa RaḥmatuLlāhi wa Barakātuh. Aʻūdhu BiLlāhi Minash-shayṭāni r-rajīm. BismiLlāhi r-Raḥmāni r-Raḥīm. Wa ṣ-Salātu wa s-Salāmu 'alá Rasūlinā Muḥammadin Sayyidi l-Awwalīna wa l-Akhirīn. Madad yā RasūlAllāh, Madad yā Sādāti Aṣḥābi RasūliLlāh, Madad yā Mashāyikhinā, Dastūr Mawlana Sheikh Abdullāh al-Fā'iz ad-Dāghistāni, Sheikh Muḥammad Nāzim al-Ḥaqqānī. Madad.

Last time we stopped at this hadīth about combining prayers. Let's read it once again; it's important.

1- *Qala RasuluLlah salla Llāhu 'alayhi wa-sallam*The Messenger of Allāh & (peace be upon him) says:

Our Holy Prophet is saying, "Whoever combines two Fard prayers without excuse, has opened and passed through one of the doors of the major sins." So, it's okay if there's an excuse. It could be raining or there might be danger. It's okay if he prays them both separately, because he won't be able to pray one. If he is excused like that, it's okay.

Normally, as we said, in the Hanafi Madhhab, it is not on the day of Eid, but on 'Arafat. In Arafat, he combines Dhuhr and Asr, Maghrib and 'Isha. In other Madhhabs, when he is traveling on a journey, he can combine two. For example, in Shafi'i they can combine Dhuhr and Asr if on a journey. He can also combine Maghrib and 'Isha. He can combine them either before or after. They become of the same account and same reward; if there is no deficiency.

But there is a point here, the journey's duration according to Shafi'i is three days. It is not fifteen days like Hanafi. If he travels for three days, it is okay. However, if he goes out on a journey and stays for more than three days, he mustn't combine prayers for more than three days. Then, he has to pray normally; he has to pray four rak'ats and pray like a normal resident who is not on a journey.

2- *Qala RasuluLlah salla Llāhu 'alayhi wa-sallam*The Messenger of Allāh (peace be upon him) says:

أفضلُ الأَيَّامِ عندَ اللهِ يومُ الجمعةِ

Our Holy Prophet is saying, "The most virtuous day in the sight of Allah is Friday." There is the most virtuous among everything in the sight of Allah. The most virtuous is our Prophet ṣallá Llāhu 'alayhi wa-sallam. He also gives him the most virtuous things. And Friday was given to our Prophet ṣallá Llāhu 'alayhi wa-sallam, as his day and as the most virtuous day in the sight of Allāh.

3- **Qala RasuluLlah salla Llāhu 'alayhi wa-sallam**The Messenger of Allāh (peace be upon him) says:

Our Holy Prophet is saying, "Indeed, Hell is kindled every day except Friday." On Friday, even Hell is calmer. On Friday, as a mercy, the fire inside it is less.

4- *Qala RasuluLlah salla Llāhu 'alayhi wa-sallam*The Messenger of Allāh (peace be upon him) says:

إنَّ لله تعالى في كل يوم جمعة ستمائة ألف عتيق يعتقهم من النار كلهم قد استوجبوا النار

Our Holy Prophet is saying, "Every Friday, there are 600 thousand people whom Allāh if frees from Hell, even though Hell is obligatory for them." For the honor of Friday, 600 people who were destined for Hell are forgiven by Allāh 'Azza wa-Jalla. They come out of the fire without entering it.

5- *Qala RasuluLlah salla Llāhu 'alayhi wa-sallam*The Messenger of Allāh & (peace be upon him) says:

من أفضلِ أيَّامِكُم يومَ الجمعةِ فيهِ خُلِقَ آدمُ وفيهِ قُبِضَ وفيهِ النَّفخةُ وفيهِ الصَّعقةُ فأكْثِروا عليَّ من الصَّلاةِ فيهِ فإنَّ صلاتَكُم معروضةٌ عليَّ. إنَّ اللَّه لصَّعقةُ فأكْثِروا عليَّ من الصَّلاةِ فيهِ فإنَّ صلاتَكُم معروضةٌ عليَّ. إنَّ اللَّه حرَّمَ على الأرضِ أن تأكُل أجسادَ الأنبياءِ

Our Holy Prophet is saying, "The most virtuous among your days is Friday." Friday is undoubtedly one of the most virtuous days. "Adam was created

on that day, his soul was taken on that day." Our father, Sayyidina Adam was created on Friday and he passed away on Friday. "The breath of air and the shout is that day." When Isrāfīl blows the trumpet and everyone dies, that day will be Friday. And on Friday, it will be blown a second time and people will be resurrected, that day they will go to the Day of Judgement. All will happen on a Friday. "Send a lot of salawāt upon me on that day. The salawāt you recite will be presented to me." Our Prophet şallá Llāhu 'aleyhi ve-sallām said, the more salawāt you make on Friday, the more blessings you receive. How lucky are those who are Muslims, for every time you make salawāt upon our Prophet , our Prophet hears and sees you. You receive his barakah. "Surely Allāh has forbidden the earth to eat the bodies of the Prophets." No matter how many Prophets there are, nothing happens to their blessed bodies; they do not rot, they do not become soil. They stay as they are. Our Holy Prophet is also Hayy (alive). He is presented the salawāt every time you recite them. There is no hour when salawāt is not said. Therefore, even if there isn't this, our Prophet is Hayy and alive in the sight of Allāh.

6- *Qala RasuluLlah salla Llāhu 'alayhi wa-sallam*The Messenger of Allāh & (peace be upon him) says:

Our Holy Prophet is saying, "The reason it is called Friday is because the creation of 'Adam was gathered, combined and completed on that day." Therefore, Friday means Jem'i, meaning to gather.

7- *Qala RasuluLlah salla Llāhu 'alayhi wa-sallam*The Messenger of Allāh (peace be upon him) says:

Our Holy Prophet is saying, "Unless you commit major sins," most people know the major sins: murder, theft, adultery, usury. "As long as these are not done, the minor sins committed from one Friday to the next will be atoned." Minor sins will be atoned. Another thing must be done for major sins.

8- *Qala RasuluLlah salla Llāhu 'alayhi wa-sallam* The Messenger of Allāh & (peace be upon him) says:

الجُمُعَةُ حَجُّ المساكِينِ

Our Holy Prophet is saying, "Friday is the pilgrimage of the Miskīn." Miskīn means the needy and poor. Friday is considered the pilgrimage of the poor who cannot go to ḥajj.

9- *Qala RasuluLlah salla Llāhu 'alayhi wa-sallam*The Messenger of Allāh (peace be upon him) says:

Our Holy Prophet sis saying, "Friday is the hajj of the poor."

10-*Qala RasuluLlah salla Llāhu 'alayhi wa-sallam*The Messenger of Allāh (peace be upon him) says:

خيرُ يومٍ طلعَتْ عليهِ الشمسُ يومُ الجمعَةِ فيهِ خُلِقَ آدَمُ، وفِيهِ أُدْخِلَ الجنَّةَ، وفيهِ أُخْرِجَ منهَا، ولا تَقُومُ الساعةُ إلا في يومِ الجمعَةِ

Our Holy Prophet is saying, "The best day on which the sun rises is Friday." The best of the seven days is Friday. "Adam was created on that day." Allah Azza wa Jalla created Adam on that day. "He was admitted to Paradise on that day." Allah Azza wa Jalla created Adam alayhi s-salām and put him in Paradise. "He was expelled from Paradise on that day." He was expelled on Friday. He was sent down to the world on that day. "The Day of Judgment will definitely occur on Friday." The Day of Qiyāmah is on Friday.

11- Qala RasuluLlah salla Llāhu 'alayhi wa-sallam
The Messenger of Allāh & (peace be upon him) says:

خيرُ يومٍ طَلَعتْ فيه الشمسُ يومَ الجُمُعةِ، فيه خُلِقَ آدَمُ، وفيه أُهْبِطَ، وفيه تِيبَ عليه، وفيه قُبِضَ، وفيه تقومُ الساعةُ، ما عَلَى وجهِ الأرضِ من دابة إلّا وهِيَ تُصْبِحُ يَوْمَ الْجُمُعَةِ مُصِيخَةً؛ حتى تَطْلُعَ الشمسُ شَفَقًا من الساعة؛ إلّا ابنُ آدمَ، وفيه ساعةُ لا يُصادِفُها عبدٌ مُؤمِنُ وهُو في الصلاةِ يَسألُ اللهَ شيئًا إلّا أعطاهُ إِيّاهُ

Our Holy Prophet is saying, "The best day on which the sun rises is Friday. Adam alayhi s-salām was created on that day, and he was expelled from paradise on that day." Both were on Friday. "His repentance was accepted on that day." Also, his repentance. Adam alayhi s-salām cried for repentance for 300

years. His repentance was accepted on that day, on Friday. "Qiyāmah will happen on that day." Qiyāmah will also be on Friday. "When that day comes in the morning, until the sun rises, all the creatures except mankind will wait in fear that the qiyāmah will come." All insects, animals, everything, the inanimate, stones, waters, all of them will whine with fear on that day, on Friday. They will wait in fear that qiyāmah will come. "There is an hour on that day that if a believer coincides this hour with du'ā' and asks something from Allāh in it, Allāh will definitely give him what he asks." There is an hour on Friday, that hour is the hour of acceptance. It is an hour when du'ā's are accepted and answered. If a person reaches it, Allāh 'Azza wa-Jalla will surely give that servant what he wants.

12-Qala RasuluLlah salla Llāhu 'alayhi wa-sallam

The Messenger of Allāh & (peace be upon him) says:

سيّدُ الأيَّامِ عند الله يوم الجمعةِ، وَهوَ أعظمُ من يومِ النحر والفطر، فيهِ خمسُ خلالٍ: فيه خلقَ آدمَ، وفيه أهبطَ من الجنة إلى الأرضِ، وفيهِ توفي، وفيهِ ساعةٌ لاَ يسألُ اللهَ فيها العبدُ شيئًا إلاَّ أعطاهُ إياه، ما لم يسألُ إثماً أو قطيعة رحم، وفيهِ تقومُ السَّاعةُ، وما من ملَكِ مقرَّبٍ، ولاَ سماءٍ، ولاَ أرضٍ، ولاَ ريحٍ، ولاَ جبلٍ، ولاَ مشفق من يومِ الجمعة.

Our Holy Prophet is saying, "The Master of the days in the sight of Allah is Friday." It's also a gift for our Holy Prophet #, it's a favor for his # ummah. This is a great favor, something that Allāh 48 loves has been given to us, to Ummati Muhammad , for the honor of our Prophet şallá Llāhu 'alayhi wa-sallam. "Friday is greater than the days of Eid al-Adha and Eid al-Fitr." Eid al-Fitr and Eid al-Adha are also very great days, but Friday in every week is more virtuous and greater than them, our Prophet şallá Llāhu 'alayhi wa-sallam says. "It has the following five characteristics," there are five features of Friday. "The first is that Adam was created on that day," he was created on Friday. "He was sent down to the earth on that day." The beginning of the sending down of mankind to the earth was on Friday with Adam alayhi s-salām. "He died on that day, on Friday. There is an hour on that day that when the servant makes du'a' and asks for something except for things that are forbidden, such as cutting ties of kinship, Allāh 🕸 will definitely give that person what he wants." When making du'ā', do not ask for something bad, such as "Let me win in gambling, let me buy this, let me buy that, let me do something" or one curses his relatives and wishes them evil. If one asks for anything apart from that, Allāh will definitely give that person, if he encounters that

hour. "Qiyāmah will also happen on that day. There is no close angel, the sky, the earth, the wind, the mountain or the stone that will not fear this day." People think that the inanimate do not understand anything. Whether a stone, a tree, a bird, an insect, an animal, all of them are afraid that the qiyāmah will happen on Friday.

Sadaqa RasuluLlah fi ma qal, aw kama qal.

The Messenger of Allāh says the truth in what he said or as he said.
