## Hadith Lesson: Virtues of Night Prayer

*As-Salāmu 'Alaykum wa RahmatuLlahi wa Barakatuh.*

*A'udhu BiLLāhi Minash-shayṭāni r-rajim. BismiLLāhi r-Rahmāni r-Rahīm.*

*Wa ṣ-Salātu wa s-Salamu 'alā Rasūlinā Muḥammadin Ṣayyidi l-Awwalina wa l-Akhirin.*

*Madad yā RasūlAllāh, Madad yā Sadati Aṣḥābi RasūlLlah, Madad yā Mashayikhinā,*

*Dastūr Mawlana Sheikh Abdullāh al-Fā'iẓ ad-Daghīstāni, Sheikh Muḥammad*

### 1- *Qala RasuluLlah salsa Llāhu 'alayhi wa-sallam*

The Messenger of Allāh ﷺ (peace be upon him ﷺ) says:

رَكَعْتَانِ يَرْكَعُهُمَا الْبَنُ آدَمَ فِي جَوْفِ الْلَّيْلِ الْأَخْرَى خَيْرُهُ مِنَ الدُّنْيَا وَمَا فِيهَا، وَلَوْلَا  
أَنْ أُشْقَى عَلَى أُمَّتِي لَفَرَضْتُهُمَا عَلَيْهِمْ

Our Holy Prophet ﷺ is saying, “**Two-rak’at prayer performed by the son of Adam in the last third of the night is better than this world and all that is in it. If it were not burdensome for my ummah, I would have made it obligatory for them.**” This prayer, that tahajjud prayer, is better than not only this neighborhood, but the entire world and all that is in it. Our Prophet ﷺ wanted it for his ﷺ ummah so much that if it were not burdensome, he ﷺ would have made it obligatory, says our Prophet ṣallá Llāhu 'alayhi wa-sallam. Some things are obligatory for our Prophet ﷺ but not for us. He ﷺ would've made it obligatory for us, says our Prophet ṣallá Llāhu 'alayhi wa-sallam.

### 2- *Qala RasuluLlah salsa Llāhu 'alayhi wa-sallam*

The Messenger of Allāh ﷺ (peace be upon him ﷺ) says:

شَرْفُ الْمُؤْمِنِ صِلَاتُهُ بِاللَّيْلِ وَعِزَّهُ اسْتَغْنَاؤُهُ عَمَّا فِي أَيْدِي النَّاسِ

Our Holy Prophet ﷺ is saying, “**The honor of a believer is his prayer at night.**” The person who has faith, who is a believer, has a higher honor in the sight of Allāh ﷺ. “**Being content with what you have been given and not expecting anything from people.**” That is, not expecting anything from people. That is the honor of a believer.

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## 3- *Qala RasuluLlah salla Llāhu ‘alayhi wa-sallam*

The Messenger of Allāh ﷺ (peace be upon him ﷺ) says:

صلوًامن الليل ولوأربعًا، صلوا ولور كعتين، ما مِنْ أهْلِ بَيْتٍ تُعْرَفُ لَهُمْ صلاةٌ مِنْ  
اللَّيلِ إِلَّا نَادَاهُمْ مِنْ نَادِ: يَا أَهْلَ الْبَيْتِ قَوْمُ الْصَّلَاةِ تَكُونُ

Our Holy Prophet ﷺ is saying, “**When you get up at night, pray even if four rak’āt or even if two rak’āt.**” That is, the prayer performed at the time of tahajjud at night. Qiyam ul-Layl is performed before going to bed at night. Qiyam ul-Layl is not tahajjud (the night prayer) but the prayer before going to bed. “**There is no member of a household known to pray at night except that a caller calls to them, ‘O people of the house, get up for prayer.’**” Allāh ‘Azza wa-Jalla has appointed an angel for them to wake them up for prayer at night, saying, “**Get up for prayer.**”

## 4- *Qala RasuluLlah salla Llāhu ‘alayhi wa-sallam*

The Messenger of Allāh ﷺ (peace be upon him ﷺ) says:

صَلَاةُ اللَّيْلِ مَثْنَى مَثْنَى. إِذَا خَشِيَ أَحَدُكُمُ الصَّبَحَ، صَلِّ رُكْعَةً وَاحِدَةً. قُوْتَرْ لَهُ مَا قَدْ صَلِي

Our Holy Prophet ﷺ is saying, “**The night prayer is performed in twos.**” The method of the night prayer is to pray in twos with salām, not four rak’ahs. “**If one of you fears that the time for the morning prayer will pass, he should perform one rak’ah last. He will have made the previous rak’ah one.**” The witr prayer is performed individually, one rak’ah at a time, according to the Shafī’i. Therefore, it is performed in pairs, and when it approaches the Fajr prayer, according to the Shafī’is, it becomes one. He must perform one rakat.

## 5- *Qala RasuluLlah salla Llāhu ‘alayhi wa-sallam*

The Messenger of Allāh ﷺ (peace be upon him ﷺ) says:

صَلَاةُ اللَّيْلِ مَثْنَى مَثْنَى، إِذَا خَفِتَ الصَّبَحَ فَأُوتِرْ بِوَاحِدَةٍ فَإِنَّ اللَّهَ يُحِبُّ الْوَتْرَ

Our Holy Prophet ﷺ is saying, “**The night prayer is performed in pairs,**” two rak’ahs, two rak’ahs. “**If you fear the time for Fajr prayer will pass, then perform one rak’ah last. Allāh ﷺ is One and loves what is single.**”

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6- *Qala RasuluLlah salsa Llāhu 'alayhi wa-sallam*

The Messenger of Allāh ﷺ (peace be upon him ﷺ) says:

صَلَاةُ اللَّيْلِ وَالنَّهَارِ مَثْنَى مَثْنَى

Our Holy Prophet ﷺ is saying, “**Nafilah prayers are performed in pairs during the day and night.**”

7- *Qala RasuluLlah salsa Llāhu 'alayhi wa-sallam*

The Messenger of Allāh ﷺ (peace be upon him ﷺ) says:

صَلَاةُ اللَّيْلِ مَثْنَى مَثْنَى، وَجَوْفُ اللَّيْلِ أَحَقُّ بِهِ

Our Holy Prophet ﷺ is saying, “**The night prayer is performed two by two,**” two rak’ahs, two rak’ahs. “**And it is more appropriate to perform it in the middle of the night.**” So performing it before Fajr prayer is considered tahajjud, night prayer.

8- *Qala RasuluLlah salsa Llāhu 'alayhi wa-sallam*

The Messenger of Allāh ﷺ (peace be upon him ﷺ) says:

صَلَاةُ اللَّيْلِ مَثْنَى مَثْنَى، وَالوَتْرُ كَعْتُهُ فِي آخِرِ اللَّيْلِ

Our Holy Prophet ﷺ is saying, “**The night prayer is performed in twos. The witr prayer is performed at the end of the night, as a single rak’ah.**” These are according to other madhhabs. In our madhab, we already perform the witr prayer after the Isha prayer. If we leave it for later, it could happen that a person falls asleep. These are things that are done according to madhhabs.

9- *Qala RasuluLlah salsa Llāhu 'alayhi wa-sallam*

The Messenger of Allāh ﷺ (peace be upon him ﷺ) says:

اللَّيْلِ مَثْنَى مَثْنَى وَشَهَدُ فِي كُلِّ رَكْعَتَيْنِ وَتَبَاءَ سُ وَتَمَسَّكَنْ وَتَقْنِعُ بِيْدَكَ وَتَقُولُ  
اللَّهُمَّ اغْفِرْ لِي فَمَنْ لَمْ يَفْعَلْ ذَلِكَ فَهِيَ خِدَاجٌ

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Our Holy Prophet ﷺ is saying, “**The night prayer is performed in twos. After each two rak’ahs, there is a tashahhud.**” So you must certainly perform tashahhud [after each pair]. “**You raise your hands to Allāh ﷺ with humility and dignity,**” that is, you make du’ā’, “O Allāh, forgive me.” “**A person who does not do this has an incomplete prayer.**” So this means that at the end of prayer, one should raise his hands and make du’ā’, Allāh ﷺ will accept it.

10- *Qala RasuluLlah salla Llāhu ‘alayhi wa-sallam*

The Messenger of Allāh ﷺ (peace be upon him ﷺ) says:

عليكم بصلوة الليل ولو ركعة واحدة

Our Holy Prophet ﷺ is saying, “**Continue to pray at night, even if it is only one rakat.**”

11- *Qala RasuluLlah salla Llāhu ‘alayhi wa-sallam*

The Messenger of Allāh ﷺ (peace be upon him ﷺ) says:

عليكم بقيام الليل فإن دأب الصالحين قبلكم وقربة إلى الله تعالى ومنها عن  
الإثم، وتكفير للسيئات، ومطردة للداء عن الجسد

Our Holy Prophet ﷺ is saying, “**Continue to pray at night. For it is the custom of the righteous before you. It brings one closer to Allāh ﷺ.**” So the night prayer, the people of old times, the people before our Prophet ᷽allā Llāhu ‘alayhi wa-sallam, would wake up at night to pray. This brings one closer to Allāh ﷺ. “**It prevents sins**”, it keeps one away from sins. “**The night prayer is an atonement for evil deeds.**” If there are any bad deeds committed, it is an atonement for sins. “**It also repels illness from the body.**” So if one wakes up at night to pray and has an illness, that illness will surely go away.

12- *Qala RasuluLlah salla Llāhu ‘alayhi wa-sallam*

The Messenger of Allāh ﷺ (peace be upon him ﷺ) says:

فضل صلاة الليل على صلاة النهار كفضل صدقة السر على صدقة العلانية

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Our Holy Prophet ﷺ is saying, “**The superiority of the nafilah prayer at night over the prayer during the day is like the superiority of sadaqah given in secret over sadaqah given publicly.**” So the sadaqah given secretly is much more virtuous and has more rewards, just as the night prayer. Performing the night prayer when no one sees it has just the same thawāb.

*Sadaqa RasuluLlah fi ma qal, aw kama qal.*

The Messenger of Allāh ﷺ says the truth in what he ﷺ said or as he ﷺ said.
