May Allāh ﷻ not turn us away from that way, and may He ﷻ keep us steadfast, in shā’a Llāh.

Today, in shā’a Llāh, we have a journey [to England]. We are going again to our brothers, to places where Mawlānā Shaykh Nāẓim have established there, serving the whole world. There are brothers, those who remained, newcomers, and those who have passed away. It is necessary to always be together, in both dunyā and ākhirah. With that intention, in shā’a Llāh, we set out on this journey. May this journey, in shā’a Llāh, be a means of good. May we go and return in goodness. May it be good for all of us, in shā’a Llāh.
