Hadīth Lesson: On Giving Zakāt

As-Salāmu ‘Alaykum wa RahmatuLlāhi wa Barakātuh.

A‘udhu BiLlāhi Minash-shayṭāni r-rajim. BismiLlāhi r-Rahmāni r-Rahīm.

Wa ṣ-Salātu wa s-Salamu ‘alā Rasūlinā Muḥammadin Ṣayyidi l-Awwalīna wa l-Akhirin.

Madad yā RasūlAllāh, Madad yā Sadati Aṣḥābi RasūliLlāh, Madad yā Mashayikhinā,

Dastūr Mawlana Sheikh Abdullāh al-Fā’iz ad-Daghīstāni, Sheikh Muḥammad

Naṣīm al-Haqqāni. Madad.

We have finished the first book, in shā'a Llāh. We have started the second book. We will continue with the beautiful words and ḥadīths of our Prophet ṣallā Llāhu ‘alayhi wa-sallam, in shā'a Llāh.

1- *Qala RasuluLlah salla Llāhu ‘alayhi wa-sallam*

The Messenger of Allāh ﷺ (peace be upon him ﷺ) says:

إِذَا أَدَّيْتَ زَكَاءً مَا لِكَ فَقَدْ قَضَيْتَ مَا عَلَيْكَ

Our Holy Prophet ﷺ is saying, “**When you fulfill your duty by giving the zakāt of your wealth, you have paid the rights upon your wealth.**” So it is a trust upon you, and it must be given. Or else it would be as betraying the trust. Giving zakāt is obligatory. It is one of the obligatory duties of Islām. Therefore, once you have calculated and paid it, you no longer have this responsibility upon you. You will receive its reward and barakah.

2- *Qala RasuluLlah salla Llāhu ‘alayhi wa-sallam*

The Messenger of Allāh ﷺ (peace be upon him ﷺ) says:

إِذَا أَدَّيْتَ زَكَاءً مَا لِكَ، فَقَدْ أَذْهَبَتَ عَنْكَ شَرَّهُ

Our Holy Prophet ﷺ is saying, “**When you pay the zakāt of your wealth, you remove its evil from yourself.**” So if you don't pay it, it becomes evil for you; it remains with you as evil, not gain. Evil upon you is not good. To remove evil, one must purify one's wealth by giving zakāt. This way, you will be freed from evil, and earn reward from Allāh ﷺ and His ﷺ pleasure.

3- *Qala RasuluLlah salsa Llāhu ‘alayhi wa-sallam*

The Messenger of Allāh ﷺ (peace be upon him ﷺ) says:

إِن الصَّدَقَةَ لَا تُزِيدُ الْمَالَ إِلَّا كُثْرَةً

Our Holy Prophet ﷺ is saying, “**Indeed, sadaqah increases wealth.**” Don’t fear that your wealth will decrease if you give charity; on the contrary, it will increase.

4- *Qala RasuluLlah salsa Llāhu ‘alayhi wa-sallam*

The Messenger of Allāh ﷺ (peace be upon him ﷺ) says:

إِنَّ اللَّهَ لَمْ يَرِضِ الزَّكَاةَ إِلَّا يُطَيِّبَ مَا بِقِيَّ مِنْ أَمْوَالِكُمْ، وَإِنَّمَا فِرَضَ الْمَوَارِيثَ لِتَكُونَ لِمَنْ بَعْدَكُمْ. أَلَا أَخْبُرُكُمْ بِخَيْرِ مَا يَكْنِزُ الْمَرْءُ الْمَرْأَةُ الصَّالِحةُ، إِذَا نَظَرَ إِلَيْهَا سُرْتَهُ، وَإِذَا أَطَاعَتْهُ، وَإِذَا غَابَ عَنْهَا حَفْظَتْهُ

Our Holy Prophet ﷺ is saying, “**Indeed, Allāh ‘Azza wa-Jalla has made the zakāt obligatory simply to purify your remaining property.**” So when you give your zakāt for your wealth to be cleansed, that wealth becomes pure and ḥalāl. When you eat or drink, it enters your stomach as ḥalāl. It becomes ḥalāl for your family and children. If you don’t do so, then it enters inside you as evil. You would be feeding poison to your family and children. Therefore, zakāt is for purification, to purify your wealth. And don’t fear that your wealth will decrease if you give zakāt. “**And He ﷺ made inheritances obligatory so that they may remain for those who come after you.**” Inheritance is also a right. Death is a right, inheritance is ḥalāl. The wealth remaining after giving zakāt will be a rizq for the people after you. “**Let me inform you about the best a man hoards;**” That is, who or what is the best thing a person should accumulate? “**It is a it is a virtuous woman**” meaning a righteous wife. “**Who pleases him when he looks at her, obeys him when he gives her a command, and guards his interests/honor when he is away from her,**” says our Prophet shallá Llāhu ‘alayhi wa-sallam.

5- *Qala RasuluLlah salsa Llāhu ‘alayhi wa-sallam*

The Messenger of Allāh ﷺ (peace be upon him ﷺ) says:

أَقِمِ الصَّلَاةَ، وَأَذِّنَ الزَّكَاةَ، وَصَمِّرْ مَصَانَ، وَحُجَّ الْبَيْتَ، وَاعْتَمِرْ، وَبَرَّ وَالْدِيَكَ،
وَصِلْ رَحْمَكَ، وَاقْرِضِ الْضَّيْفَ، وَأَمْرَ بِالْمَعْرُوفِ، وَانْهَ عَنِ الْمُنْكَرِ، وَزُلْ مَعَ الْحَقِّ
حِثْ زَالَ

Our Holy Prophet ﷺ is saying, “**Perform your prayers correctly.**” Perform your prayers on time, in their proper place, without delay. “**Give your zakāt.**” This is a command from Allāh ﷺ and a command from our Prophet sallá Llāhu ‘alayhi wa-sallam. “**Fast Ramaḍān. Perform hajj and Umrah.**” That is, whoever is able to do so, should perform hajj and Umrah. “**Be kind to your parents.**” That is, be kind to your mother and father. “**Visit your relatives. Be hospitable to your guests. Enjoin good and forbid evil. Be with the truth wherever it may be.**” Our Prophet sallá Llāhu ‘alayhi wa-sallam said this. These are beautiful advice and commands. Believers, Muslims should strive to follow them.

6- *Qala RasuluLlah salsa Llāhu ‘alayhi wa-sallam*

The Messenger of Allāh ﷺ (peace be upon him ﷺ) says:

إِنْ فِي الْمَالِ حَقّاً سَوْيَ الزَّكَاةِ

Our Holy Prophet ﷺ is saying, “**There is something due on property apart from zakāt.**” That is, after paying zakāt, it is necessary to pay the other rights as well.

7- *Qala RasuluLlah salsa Llāhu ‘alayhi wa-sallam*

The Messenger of Allāh ﷺ (peace be upon him ﷺ) says:

لَيْسَ فِي الْمَالِ حَقٌّ سَوْيَ الزَّكَاةِ

Our Holy Prophet ﷺ is saying, “**There is nothing due on wealth other than zakāt.**” That is, if your zakāt has been paid, and you haven’t stolen, plundered, or otherwise misused someone else’s property, then that property has a right to zakāt; after it’s paid, it’s halal for you.

8- *Qala RasuluLlah salsa Llāhu ‘alayhi wa-sallam*

The Messenger of Allāh ﷺ (peace be upon him ﷺ) says:

الإِسْلَامُ أَنْ تَشْهُدَ أَنْ لَا إِلَهَ إِلَّا اللَّهُ، وَأَنْ مُحَمَّداً رَسُولُ اللَّهِ، وَتَقِيمَ الصَّلَاةَ،
وَتَؤْتِي الزَّكَاةَ، وَتَصُومُ رَمَضَانَ، وَتَحْجُجَ الْبَيْتَ إِنْ أَسْطَعْتَ إِلَيْهِ سَبِيلًا

Our Holy Prophet ﷺ is saying, “**The pillars of Islām are: bearing witness that there is no God but Allāh ﷺ and that Muhammad, ﷺ is the Messenger of Allah.**” This is the first thing. The second is prayer, “**performing prayer, giving zakāt, fasting Ramaḍān, and if you are able, performing hajj of the House, that is, the Ka’aba.**” These are the pillars of Islām, commanded by our Prophet ﷺ. These are all jewels, treasures, the treasures of the Hereafter. May Allāh ﷺ grant them to all people, in shā’ā Llāh.

Sadaqa RasuluLlah fi ma qal, aw kama qal.

The Messenger of Allāh ﷺ says the truth in what he ﷺ said or as he ﷺ said.
