'Wa 'Idhā Al-Bihāru Fujjirat', 'And when the seas are burst forth.' (Qur'ān 82:03).
Ṣadaqa Llāhu l-'Azīm. Allāh 'Azza wa-Jalla is telling us about the Day of Judgment.
People think that everything will continue forever, that nothing will happen. But the Day
of Judgment is coming; Allāh 'Azza wa-Jalla says that the sky will split open, the stars will
scatter, and the seas will burst and overflow.

Years ago, we went to Italy, where a volcano erupted. The huge mountain was
practically destroyed. They say, "It's nothing. The real issue is this sea." The scientists are
also saying so. There is a huge volcano inside it. If it erupts, the world will be destroyed;
nothing will remain. They are afraid of these things. There is nothing to fear. Everything
is waiting for Allāh's ﷻ command; nothing will happen until Allāh 'Azza wa-Jalla's
command comes. It will happen when the time comes. Qur'ān 'Azīmu sh-Sha' n also
states this: the seas will burst open. The Day of Judgment will come, nothing will remain.
There will be no mountaintop left; everything will be completely flat. These are things
that will happen. Although Allāh 'Azza wa-Jalla informed about these things, and
although they know this, only some come to īmān; most don't care. They dismiss it,
saying, "This is a natural event, we cannot do anything about it." They have no fear of
Allāh ﷻ; they only say things such as "A rock from the sky will strike earth." Some
Muslims who believe this also have weak īmān. īmān is believing that these things will
happen when the time comes, and that whatever Allāh 'Azza wa-Jalla has said will be
fulfilled.

Therefore, look at your own situation. Without looking at others, without fearing
anything; what Allāh ﷻ says will happen, there's no need for anything. What difference
does it make whether you fear or not? If you are going to fear, fear Allāh ﷻ, and nothing
else. May Allāh ﷻ protect us and our īmān. That is what is important, nothing else.

Whether a meteorite strikes, a volcano erupts, or an earthquake occurs - all of these happen only by the command of Allāh ‘Azza wa-Jalla. This is what needs to be known. This is what īmān is.
