As we have said, our Prophet ṣallā Llāhu ‘alayhi wa-sallam is the one who teaches the most Adab (manners). He ﷺ is the one who teaches all Adab and morals. Whoever follows his ﷺ way and adheres to his ﷺ Sunnah becomes one of the servants beloved by Allāh ﷻ. Every aspect of our Holy Prophet’s ﷺ life is beautiful, everything he ﷺ does is beautiful. He ﷺ is beneficial to people. Nothing he ﷺ does is in vain. The Qur’ān says, ‘وَمَا يَنْطِقُ عَنِ الْهَوَىٰ’, ‘Nor does he speak out of desire.’ (Qur’ān 53:03). He does not speak from his ﷺ own whims and desires. Every aspect of his ﷺ life, every action, is Sunnah; it is a lesson for people.

Today, there are those who want to emulate him ﷺ, and those who don’t. Those who don’t want to emulate him ﷺ are the people of shayṭān. They do not accept the Sunnah. They make “Sunnahs” according to their own minds, and when they see the true Sunnah, they dislike it. Therefore, if you want to be a servant beloved by Allāh ﷻ, strive to do everything that our Prophet ṣallā Llāhu ‘alayhi wa-sallam did. He ﷺ has both forgotten and remembered Sunnah practices. Our Prophet ṣallā Llāhu ‘alayhi wa-sallam said: “مَنْ أَحْيَا سُنَّتِي عِنْدَ فُسَادِ أُمَّتِي فَلَهُ أَجْرُ مِائَةِ شَهِيدٍ”, “Whoever revives my Sunnah when my Ummah is corrupted, Allāh ﷻ will reward him with the reward of one hundred martyrs.” There are many forgotten Sunnahs that most people don’t even know exist. Whoever revives these Sunnahs and tells them to people will earn the reward of one hundred martyrs.

Therefore, being with our Prophet ṣallā Llāhu ‘alayhi wa-sallam is the greatest blessing. Showing him ﷺ respect and reverence is the greatest blessing for us. Because there are many people who claim to be Muslim but do not value him ﷺ at all. Many follow those who cannot see the greatness of our Prophet ṣallā Llāhu ‘alayhi wa-sallam, who do not respect him ﷺ, and who speak ill of him ﷺ. Therefore, those who are on this righteous way are the servants whom Allāh ﷻ loves. Allāh ﷻ will reward them Himself. Their way is light; their hearts are filled with light, faith, and happiness. Those who are not on his ﷺ way are in distress; they cause distress to themselves and those around them. They never find peace; their hearts and faces are darkened. Everything they do is evil. May Allāh ﷻ protect us from their evil.
